A ‘magic hosepipe’ is located at the side of Christ Church (combination code 1693). Un-reel all of the hose, (best not to pull on the ‘magic hose’) turn on the water This hose will reach the 2 tubs at the War Memorial, 3 hay racks on the Heritage Centre railings, the large box on the corner of the pond, the WI box and the 4 tubs outside the church, 5 hayracks on the curved wall. When watering the hayracks on the Village Hall railings ensure the pipe connectors are not laid on the road. Please turn off the water and rewind the hose after use.

A hosepipe is available at the rear of Ewan’s Mere Cottage (attached to Mere House). This will water the sycamore bed, the hayrack on the wall of Ewan’s Mere Cottage Please rewind hosepipes and detach from the tap. Watering cans are also available.

At the western end of the pond, a hosepipe at Mere Flats will water the adjacent flower beds and the tubs near the bowling club. The tub near the Surgery entrance needs a watering can. Please do not water the new community garden from the driveway to Mere flats as this causes soil to wash down onto the new paved area and the benches: it is better to water from the new paved area. Please water the hayracks at Stanifords Estate Agency on Sundays and bank holidays. Finally, as we all probably know, evening watering is better than daytime in the hot sun. Recent rain does not necessarily mean we don’t have to water.
