A hose pipe is located at the side of Christ Church, access by combination padlock code 1693. This hose will reach the 2 tubs at the War Memorial, 3 hay racks on the Heritage Centre railings, the new hay racks on the corner of the pond, the WI box and the 4 tubs outside the church. When watering the hayracks on the Village Hall railings, you will now find a tap to the left of the Main Entrance Door outside. This has the same combination lock code 1693. We suggest you use watering cans although there may be the option of a hose if this proves possible. Please turn off the water and rewind the hose after use. Watering cans are also available.

At the western end of the pond, a hosepipe at Mere Flats will water the adjacent flower beds and the tubs near the bowling club & the hayrack on the Swan sign post.

Finally, as we all probably know, evening watering is better, if possible, than daytime in the hot sun. Recent rain does not necessarily mean we don't have to water.
