ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 SECTION 14 (1)
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH TRAFFIC
West End, Swanland

Notice is hereby given that The East Riding of Yorkshire Council intends not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding along West End, Swanland between No:20 West End and the junction with Queensbury Way commencing 17th January 2022 to allow works to improve the infrastructure by replacing the water main.

The road closure is necessary to enable the works to be carried out in a manner consistent with ensuring the safety of the public. The Order is valid for 18 months, but it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 28th February 2022.

The alternative route for traffic affected by the road closure will be via:

West End, Mill Road, Melton Bottom, Melton Bottom Roundabout, South Lawn Way, Woodside Bridge North Roundabout, Woodside Bridge, Woodside Bridge South Roundabout, Melton Road, High Street, Swanland Hill, Kemp Road and vice versa

The diversion route will be signed at the time of closure. The road will be closed to all traffic but access will be maintained for pedestrians, residents and emergency services.
