The Co-ordinators meet three times a year to review any incidents of crime and to discuss crime prevention measures. A Police Community Support Officer usually attends Co-ordinator meetings to answer questions about security and to review the latest crime reports for Swanland. Everyone is welcome to attend the Street Co-ordinators meetings, which are held, every four months, in the Church Hall at Christ Church. Dates of meetings are shown on the village website.
